Any queries regarding the electoral roll may be addressed to the Chief Election Commissioner in writing by 15th July, 2010 by 5.00 p.m.

Members of OSWB, who would like to represent the Society at the AIOS as Managing Committee Members, submit their names to the Society office along with AIOS and OSWB Membership Nos. (with year of admission in AIOS and OSWB) by 30th July, 2010 (by 5.00pm). A maximum of two members of OSWB can represent the Society at AIOS. In case the numbers of applications exceed two, election will be held on the same date as Vice President Election during the same time frame.

In order for a member to be a member of Managing Committee of AIOS, the following criteria have to be fulfilled as per AIOS stipulation (Rule 16 C of Rules and Regulations of All India Ophthalmological Society as published in May 2009 under Memorandum, Rules & Regulations and Bye Laws):

- a) Must have been a member of good standing of the society for 5 years.
- b) Attended at least two annual conferences of the society.
- c) Should have actively participated in scientific/organizational activities of the Society.
