**Basics of Phacoemulsification surgery**

The cataracts in India are becoming softer, the economy is getting better and phaco-machines and foldable IOL's are touching affordability. Having learned Manual SICS, we need to convert to a more satisfying phacoemulsification procedure. This instruction course offers a step-by-step conversion from Manual SICS to phacoemulsification through video assisted teaching materials. The course includes common learning problems as recorded through the trainee's performance to the effective management of the situation by the supervising experienced phaco-surgeons. Using the SICS nucleus in a goat's eye to practice the steps in phacoemulsification is shown through video assisted teaching. The basics of phacodynamics is explained through animation. The various steps, rhexis, automated IA, incision, sideports, nuclear rotation, trenching, cracking, quadrant emulsification and chopping are explained with videos and animation.

**Abstract :** This video based course will deal with management strategies of tight situations and avoiding impending disasters and complications while managing rockhard cataracts, soft cataracts in high myopes and post Lasik cases, posterior polar cataracts, cataracts with small pupil and loose lenses, pediatric cataracts, and patients with premium IOLs. Management strategies of posterior capsular rupture with vitrectomy for anterior segment surgeons would also be discussed.
